



Tungsten TRYCON AI Global Markets

Monthly Comment

In a slightly negative equity market environment, the portfolio suffered moderate losses from trading in equity indices. The weakest contribution came from the AEX index, which fell following disappointing data from chipmaker ASML. The strategy also incurred losses in other European indices, such as the IBEX 35, which were at least partially offset by gains in US and Asian indices. The small loss in government bond trading was mainly due to long positions in German and UK government bonds. The latter came under pressure following the UK government's budget plans. On the other hand, the strategy benefited from a short position in 10-year US government bonds. Currency trading was profitable as the strategy benefited from the weakness of the Japanese yen, euro and Swiss franc against the US dollar, while posting small losses in the British pound and the Australian Dollar. Fluctuations in equity volatility markets led to small losses and there was also a net loss in money market futures, mainly due to a rise in USD interest rates at the beginning of the month.

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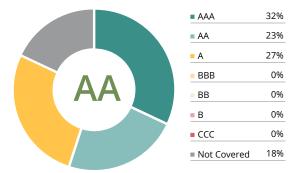


Fund description

The fund's objective is to provide absolute returns with a moderate risk profile and low correlation to equity markets and other investments. The underlying trading models are based on Artificial Intelligence.

The Tungsten TRYCON AI Global Markets pursues a systematic multi-asset long/short strategy. Since September 2013, it uses quantitative models based on Artificial Intelligence to identify trading opportunities in the financial markets. Periodic re-learning leads to regular updates of the models. The investment universe comprises some 60 global equity, bond, interest rate and currency markets. In these markets, the fund can take both long and short positions using regulated, liquid and exchange-traded financial instruments. The portfolio is dynamically adjusted to changing market conditions in accordance with a strict risk management. The strategy is characterized by low correlation with traditional investments.

MSCI ESG rating and distribution








